



Uniform List 2019-20

Thank you for sending the children to school in full uniform – they look very smart.
PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING OR EQUIPMENT ARE CLEARLY NAMED!

School Uniform

Green sweatshirt or cardigan with logo
Grey school-style trousers or grey skirt or grey shorts (summer)
Plain white or logo green polo shirt
Green checked dress (summer)
Black, white or grey socks/tights, black shoes.
Dark green or black hair ribbon/bobble/hair band. Large 'Jo-Jo bows' are not suitable for school.

Shoes should be **plain black**, with flat heels.

Boots, trainers and open-toed/slingback shoes are not suitable to be worn in school.

Shirts are worn tucked into trousers or skirts.

P.E. Kit

School PE kit consists of:

Black or navy blue shorts, plain **white** teeshirt (without logo, not a football shirt), **black pumps**.

These items should be named and kept in school in a named nylon PE bag. They should be taken home each half term for washing.

In colder weather children may bring in a plain **black or navy track** suit. Trainers can be brought in for outdoor PE lessons.

Long hair must be tied up for PE – please provide a bobble.

Jewellery

Children may wear **one** pair of **small, plain, gold stud earrings**. Other styles and colours are not acceptable.

They will be expected to remove earrings for PE.

If younger children are unable to remove their own earrings, please ensure that they are taken out at home on PE days. If earrings cannot be removed, please supply plasters to cover them for PE.

Tattoos/transfers/make-up/nail polish/false nails are not appropriate at school – please save these for the holidays and ensure that they are removed for school days.

Bags

We have very little space in school for storage of bags – please ensure that bags brought into school are small – they only need to hold reading books and reading records. Other equipment will be provided in school.
