<u>English</u> Reading

This term, children will be expected to read a range of different non-fiction and fiction texts on *Farms*. They will be expected to explain their understanding of these text by predicting and answering questions based on what they have read. They will take part in whole class reading sessions to extend and consolidate reading skills.

Parents should ensure that children are reading at home and recording in diaries.

Grammar and Punctuation

Children will be working on a range of grammar and punctuation skills in order to improve their writing. These skills will include commas in a list, exclamation marks and apostrophes. Checking for the correct tense is important.
